The path to a happy life.

“Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.”

Mercy, a thread passing through God’s revelation to us, is intimately associated with justice. Even when we sin, God’s mercy remains. As Exodus says and the Psalms repeat: “The Lord is merciful and gracious, He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.” (ps 103)). In Jesus’ teaching, the parable of the prodigal son reflects God’s mercy.

Mercy tears down barriers between people just as Jesus turned the other cheek, so we, as Christians disciples, are called to be merciful when given the opportunity to be reconciled with someone who has wronged us. Like Jesus, a disciple responds with mercy. Each day ask yourself what would Pope Francis say or do.
