Upper Room

Scripture says that Mary and the disciples were gathered together in the Upper Room when the Holy Scripture descended upon them. Where was that Upper Room? The room is also known as the Cenacle. Scripture scholars believe it was the second floor of a synagogue located on Mount Zion.

Since the 4th century the site has also been thought to be the room where the Last Supper took place.

During the destruction of Jerusalem, in 70 A.D., the room was spared any damage and soon became known as the Church of the Apostles. That Church was later torn down and replaced by a new church in 382, which itself was destroyed nearly 300 years later when the Persians invaded Jerusalem. Crusaders built the present church in the 12th century. The structure retains portions of the original walls. The first floor of the Cenacle is also believed to contain King David's burial place. Currently Christians are allowed to pray at the Cenacle, but NO official Masses are permitted.

First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:12-20

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

Gospel: Luke 23:35-43

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read "This is the king of the Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in his kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."
